Now that you've selected your new wardrobe range, take a look through the wide selection of surrounds (door panels, wall scribe, end panel, floor plinth) and door trim colours.

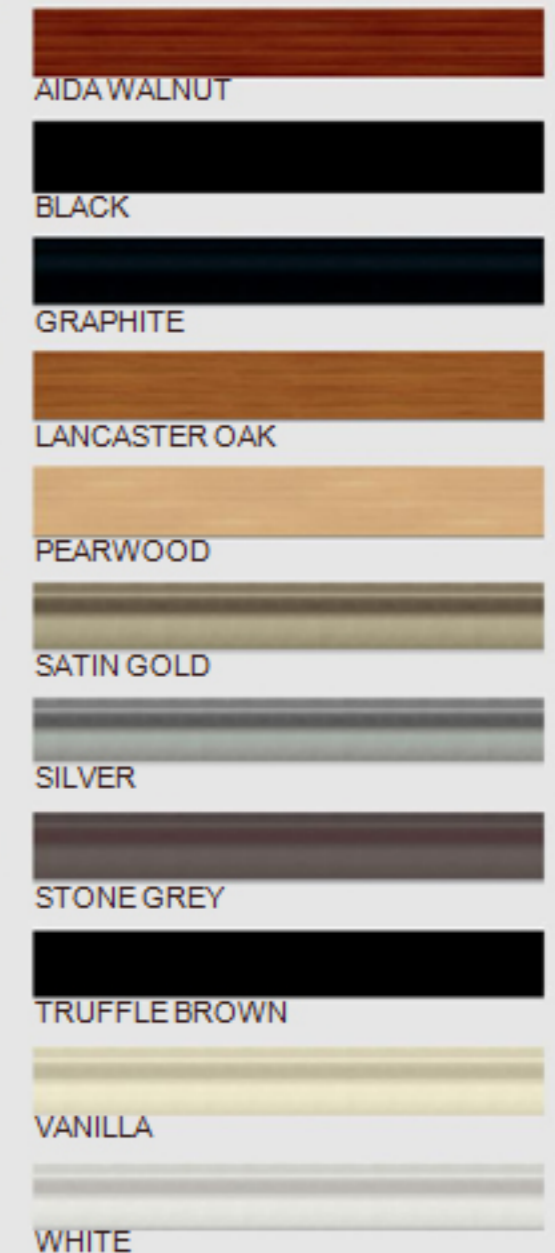

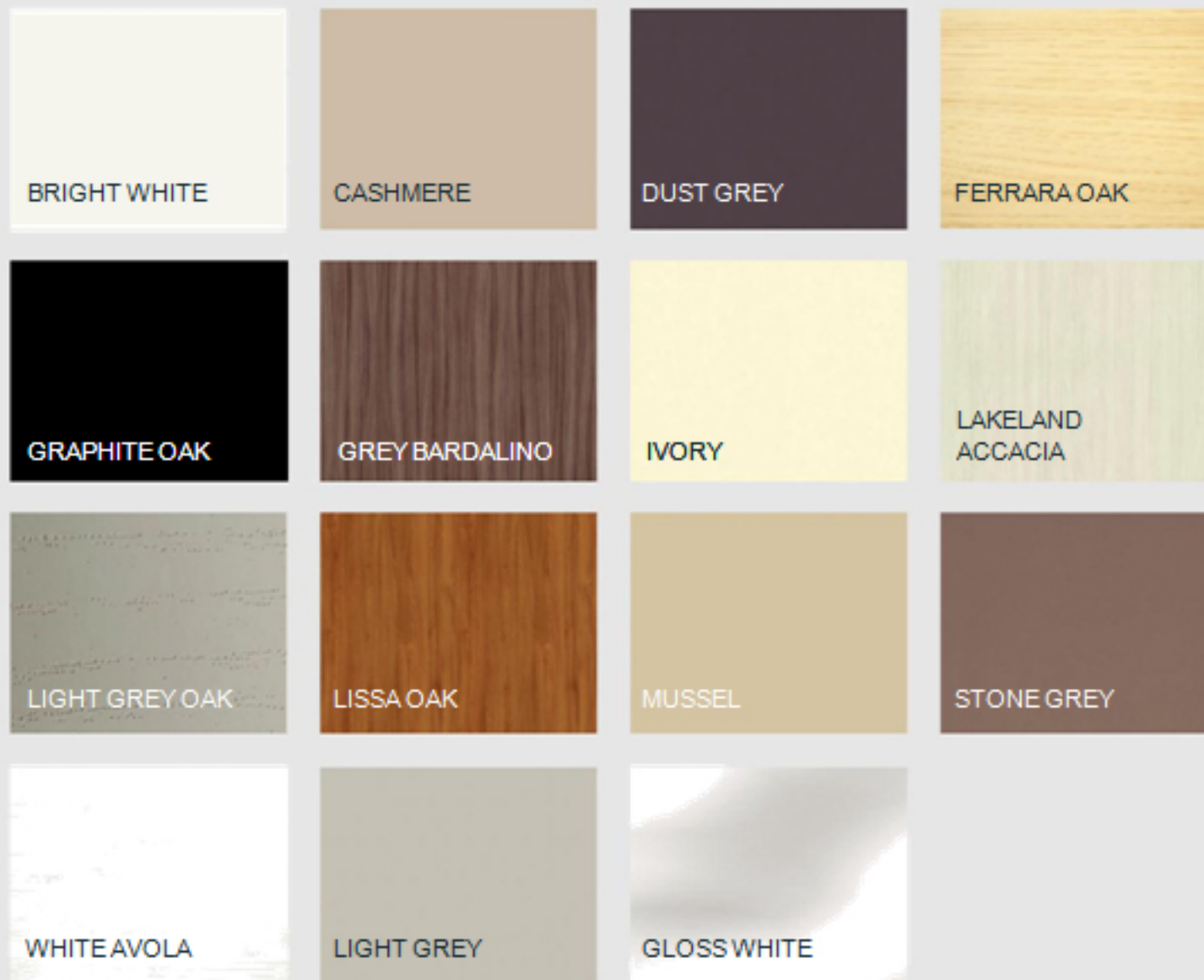

SURROUNDS AND TRIMS

WHAT IS A DOOR PANEL?

This is the centre of the wardrobe door. It can be in woodgrain or a plain colour or mirror or coloured glass depending on the style of the wardrobe.

WHAT IS DOOR TRIM?

This is the trim that goes around the door panel both at the sides of the door and at the top and bottom of the door. The door trim usually matches the door panel but a contrasting colour can be chosen if preferred.

WHAT IS A WALL SCRIBER?

A Wall Scriber is usually required where the doors of the wardrobe come up to a wall and an existing skirting board. The Wall Scriber fills in the space created by the skirting board.

WHAT IS AN END PANEL?

If a wardrobe doesn't stretch from wall to wall but ends part way across a room, an End Panel would be required. End Panels usually match the colour of the doors.

WHAT IS FLOOR PLINTH?

This is a small platform that can go underneath the bottom track and usually matches the scribes or end panel.
